I ask for the grace to reconcile my relationship with God, creation, and humanity. I ask for the strength not to look for an easy life, but to strive for God’s peace

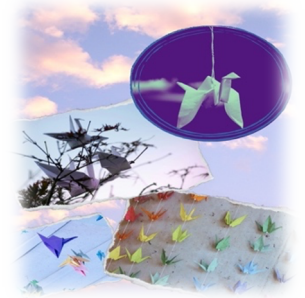
Invitation to action
